Honolulu-based GPS Heroes acquired by New Jersey company

Neptune, New Jersey-based WorkWave has acquired GPS Heroes, a Honolulu-based company that provides businesses with tracking solutions for their vehicles and assets.

GPS Heroes, which is headquartered in Honolulu, also has an office in Winchester, California.

WorkWave, which provides cloud-based field service management and fleet management software solutions, will retain the entire GPS Heroes team including the Honolulu office.

“The plan is to retain and grow the team in Honolulu with the help of WorkWave’s knowledge and expertise, along with expanded resources, allowing us to retain and ultimately grow our customer base in the islands,” Don Mastrangelo, GPS Heroes founder and CEO told Pacific Business News.

Mastrangelo said WorkWave will utilize the Honolulu office to provide additional support for its customers on the Mainland’s West Coast.

Mastrangelo added that GPS Heroes’ customers will now be able to access WorkWave’s “enhanced feature set” that includes enhanced dispatching, route optimization and field service management.
